

THE KIDS SUMMER CAFÉ IS A FOOD N' FRIENDS PROGRAM THAT COMBATS CHILDHOOD HUNGER BY PROVIDING CHILDREN A HEALTHY LUNCH WHEN SCHOOL IS NOT IN SESSION. MANY CHILDREN WHO RECEIVE FREE OR REDUCED LUNCHES DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR FACE A HIGH RISK OF HUNGER WHEN SCHOOL IS OUT FOR THE SUMMER. FREE BAGGED LUNCHES ARE DISTRIBUTED THREE TIMES A WEEK AT 3 LOCAL PLAYGROUNDS TO SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN.
